- Implement all reasonable efforts in terms of organization, operations and technology to prevent air, water and soil pollution;
- Minimize the consumption of energy, water and materials and the production of waste, encouraging recovery and recycling where possible;
- Establish environmental objectives and targets, integrated with plant management and improvement programs;
- Ensure that the Environmental Policy outlined here and its Management System are understood, implemented and maintained at all organizational levels, and that the system is supported by regularly scheduled training programs;
- Ensure that this document is made available to the public.
